NEW PET CARE FACILITY IN GEORGETOWN ANNOUNCES OPENING  
Zoot Pet Hospital + Luxury Boarding Now Open and Ready for Pets

Zoot Pet Hospital + Luxury Boarding, a full-service veterinary care and pet boarding facility newly built in Georgetown, is opening its doors to pet owners at the beginning of July. The pet boarding suites are scheduled to open Tuesday, July 1 and the veterinary care center will open the following week on July 8.

Zoot Pets, a joint venture of partners Jim Root and Dr. Wayne Zeh, DVM, combines professional veterinary care with comfortable, suite-only pet boarding. A trained animal chiropractor will also be on site. The staff members at Zoot have prepared to embrace a philosophy of treating every pet like a member of their own families, and providing outstanding customer service that will ease the minds of pet owners who bring in their animals for care. "In a nutshell, Zoot stands for peace of mind for you and your pet," said Jim Root, President and co-owner of Zoot Pet Hospital + Luxury Boarding.

The Zoot facility is the only one of its kind in the Austin area. The space is equally divided between the veterinary and boarding services, each with its own separate full staff. The building's industrial Texas hill country style of architecture and design, both inside and out, suggest anything but a veterinary center. From the outside, it appears to be more like a hill country resort. Inside, spacious rooms and warm colors provide a welcoming atmosphere for both pets and owners. The waiting lounge is even complete with a working fireplace, children's play area and Starbucks coffee. Zoot was designed the collaborative efforts of Georgetown architect Rick O'Donnell and veterinary architect Dan Chapel of Little Rock, Ark. Gary Henley of Henley Homes, Inc., a building firm in Liberty Hill, oversaw construction of this 15,000 square foot facility.

The pet suites are also unlike any other. The private indoor/outdoor patio suites for dogs, all cage-free, provide a comfortable place for their stay. Adjoining rooms can also be reserved for dog families. Suites vary in size; the larger suites are equipped with flat panel TVs and 24-hour webcam access for owners. Cats are housed in Zoot's second-floor condos, built with windows that overlook the lobby and provide great views of the hill country. And all animals, regardless of size, will have plenty of room to run in the property's outdoor play meadows — the Zoot facility sits on four private acres.

Zoot Pet Hospital + Luxury Boarding is located at 3981 Highway 29 West, just 3.5 miles west of Wolf Ranch Town Center in Georgetown. (512) 864-ZOOT; <http://www.zootpets.com/>
